
The **Syrex (Pty) Ltd** B-BBEE certificate number **417/B-BBEE: GEN-ICT-SC/12/04/2016** will expire on the **11 April 2017** and the next verification certificate will only be available post the company's financial year end **June 2017**. This is because **Syrex (Pty) Ltd** is opting to align its B-BBEE reporting to its financial reporting process, as per the definition of the measurement period in the Draft Amended Verification Manual (Gazette No 39378) which was released in November 2015.

Practice in the verification industry is that all current and valid certificates are accepted as proof of a suppliers B-BBEE status as well as certificates issued at any time during the measured entities measurement period. So this means that if **Syrex (Pty) Ltd** B-BBEE certificate was valid for one day during your verification period, it will be accepted as a valid B-BBEE certificate.
